# Heaven Can Wait

## LODGE

### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

**From Seattle**, take I-90 east over Snoqualmie Pass to Cle Elum. Take EXIT 85 (HWY 970 to Wenatchee) in ten miles it joins and becomes HWY 97. Continue North on HWY 97 to the junction with HWY 2, turn left onto Hwy 2 (west toward Leavenworth approximately 4 miles). Upon entering Leavenworth, go past the stoplight at the Safeway store and over the bridge and turn right at the next light on to State Route 209 "Chumstick Canyon Rd." Head West toward Plain/Seattle on SR 209. Go over Beaver Pass and down into the small town of Plain (SR 209 turns right at the bottom of the pass and Plain, WA is comprised of three commercial structures on your left: a café, grocery store, and hardware/antique store) Continue past Plain on SR 209 when the road turns 90 degrees to the Left you continue straight onto Chiwawa Loop Road. (if you get to the Wenatchee river Bridge within 1/3 of a mile you have missed Chiwawa Loop Rd.) Continue on Chiwawa Loop Road 2.1 miles, and turn left on Shugart Flats Road (the first road you come to). Follow this road 1.2 miles till the road comes to a T intersection, turn right on W. Shugart Flats Road. After .7 mile and at the bottom of a short hill, on your right is a huge log entry framing the entrance to Heaven Can Wait Lodges driveway. Turn right and follow the driveway to the Lodge.

**From Everett**, take HWY 2 east over Stevens Pass and through the beautiful Tumwater Canyon. Continue through Leavenworth until you reach the second stoplight, turn left on State Route 209 "Chumstick Canyon Rd." Head West toward Plain/Seattle on SR 209. Go over Beaver Pass and down into the small town of Plain (SR 209 turns right at the bottom of the pass and Plain, WA is comprised of three commercial structures on your left: a café, grocery store, and hardware/antique store) Continue past Plain on SR 209 when the road turns 90 degrees to the Left you continue straight onto Chiwawa Loop Road. (if you get to the Wenatchee river Bridge within 1/3 of a mile you have missed Chiwawa Loop Rd.) Continue on Chiwawa Loop Road 2.1 miles, and turn left on Shugart Flats Road (the first road you come to). Follow this road 1.2 miles till the road comes to a T intersection, turn right on W. Shugart Flats Road. After .7 mile and at the bottom of a short hill, on your right is a huge log entry framing the entrance to Heaven Can Wait Lodges driveway. Turn right and follow the driveway to the Lodge.

**From Spokane**, take I-90 west past Moses Lake to George. Take HWY 281 to Quincy. In Quincy take HWY 28 to Wenatchee. Continue north through East Wenatchee on HWY 28 (Sunset Road) to the intersection of HWY 2/HWY97. Turn left onto HWY 2/HWY97 cross the Columbia River and follow Hwy 2 west toward Leavenworth (approximately 18 miles). Continue through Leavenworth until you reach the second stoplight, turn left on State Route 209 "Chumstick Canyon Rd." Head West toward Plain/Seattle on SR 209. Go over Beaver Pass and down into the small town of Plain (SR 209 turns right at the bottom of the pass and Plain, WA is comprised of three commercial structures on your left: a café, grocery store, and hardware/antique store) Continue past Plain on SR 209 when the road turns 90 degrees to the Left you continue straight onto Chiwawa Loop Road. (if you get to the Wenatchee river Bridge within 1/3 of a mile you have missed Chiwawa Loop Rd.) Continue on Chiwawa Loop Road 2.1 miles, and turn left on Shugart Flats Road (the first road you come to). Follow this road 1.2 miles till the road comes to a T intersection, turn right on W. Shugart Flats Road. After .7 mile and at the bottom of a short hill, on your right is a huge log entry framing the entrance to Heaven Can Wait Lodges driveway. Turn right and follow the driveway to the Lodge.

## Be Prepared for Winter Driving

Protect yourself and your passengers. Allow extra time to reach your destination during inclement weather. It takes only one unprepared or careless driver to slow or stop traffic.

### Practice the following:

- Drive for conditions – slower speeds, slower acceleration.
- Check to see if you have traction tires.
- Know what the traction advisories mean.
- Watch a video to learn how to install tire chains.
- Do not use cruise control.
- **Four-wheel and all-wheel vehicles do not stop or steer better on ice.**
- Leave extra room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you.
- Slow down when approaching intersections, offramps, bridges, or shady spots.
- If you find yourself behind a snowplow, slow down and give the plow a little extra room.
- Slow down and be extra cautious near the chain-up and removal areas. There are often people out of their vehicles.
- Keep your fuel tank full — don't let it fall below half a tank on winter trips.
- Program your radio for traffic reports and emergency messages (for WSDOT radio: 530 and 1610 AM).

### What to carry on winter trips:

### **Winter Driving Supply Checklist**

- Keep a basic winter survival kit in your vehicle: flashlight, batteries, blanket, snacks, water, gloves, boots, first-aid kit.
- Load your car with winter travel gear : tire chains, ice scraper/snowbrush, jumper cables, road flares.

### **What would cause the pass to close:**

#### **Blocking Vehicles**

#### **Avalanche Control**

When possible avalanche control work is scheduled at night when traffic volumes are low. WSDOT attempts to provide advance notice, but in an emergency, it's not always possible.

#### **Road Clearing**

If there is heavy snow in a short amount of time, road crews may close the pass to clear ice and snow from the travel lanes.
